1 General Information



1 General Information



Carefully read these instructions before installation and commissioning. Save these instructions in the vicinity of the installation for future reference.

1.1 Scope of these instructions

These instructions describe the installation, commissioning and function of a floor distribution manifold for the flat station HomeBloC[®] Digital.

For other components, please follow the instructions of the respective manufacturer. The chapters marked with [specialist] are intended for specialists only.

The floor distribution manifold complies with the relevant directives and is therefore labelled with the CE mark. The Declaration of Conformity is available upon request, please contact the manufacturer.

1.2 Designated use

The product may only be used taking into consideration these instructions and the technical limit values indicated in these instructions.

The product is intended for use in a domestic environment. The product can also be used in nondomestic environments, e.g. in small businesses, provided it is used in the same way.

Only use original accessories with the product. Improper usage of the product excludes any liability claims.



2 Safety instructions

The installation and commissioning as well as the connection of electrical components require technical knowledge commensurate with a recognised vocational qualification as a fitter for plumbing, heating and air conditioning technology, or a profession requiring a comparable level of knowledge [specialist].

The following must be observed during installation and commissioning:

- relevant local and national regulations
- accident prevention regulations of the professional association
- instructions and safety instructions mentioned in these instructions

A CAUTION



Personal injury and damage to property!

The product must only be used in heating circuits filled with heating water according to VDI 2035 / Ö-Norm H 5195-1.

• The product must **not** be used in drinking water applications.

NOTICE

Material damage due to mineral oils!

Mineral oil products cause lasting damage to seals made of EPDM, whereby the sealant properties are lost. We do not assume liability nor provide warranty for damage to property resulting from sealants damaged in this way.

- It is imperative to prevent the EPDM sealing elements from making contact with substances containing mineral oils.
- ► Use a silicone- or polyalkylene-based lubricant free of mineral oil such as Unisilikon L250L and Syntheso Glep 1 from Klüber or a silicone spray.

NOTICE

Material damage due to unsuitable tools!

Multifunctional tools, such as water pump pliers or adjustable spanners, quickly cause damage to the valves and screw connections.

• Only use suitable tools for any work on the product.

Material damage due to cleaning agents containing alcohol!

Cleaning agents containing alcohol damage the product, which can lead to leaks. We do not assume liability nor provide warranty for damage to property resulting from products damaged in this way.

- Avoid at all costs that the product comes into contact with substances containing alcohol.
- Use alcohol-free cleaning agents and a clean cloth for cleaning.

3 Product description

The product consists of the floor distribution manifold and a ball valve rail including ball valves for mounting on flat stations of the HomeBloC[®] Digital series.

The PAW flat station HomeBloC[®] Digital and the wall-mounted or flush-mounted cupboard are not included in the scope of delivery and must be ordered separately!



- A Adjusting wrench for flow limiter
- B Flow meter / flow limiter on the flow distribution manifold

4 Mounting and installation [specialist]

NOTICE

Damage to property!

The installation site must be dry, stable, frost-proof and protected against ultraviolet radiation in order to prevent material damage of the installation.

4.1 Installation

NOTICE

Damage to property!

The floor circuit pump (P2) can be protected in the controller via a thermostat (safety temperature limiter). This is necessary if the heat generator temperature can be higher than the maximum floor circuit temperature (due to the material or the surface temperature). A corresponding temperature thermostat must be provided by the customer and is available from PAW accessories (item no. 1280601101). Non-observance can lead to damage to the building.

NOTICE

The following description assumes the use of a PAW wall-mounted or flush-mounted cupboard. Please observe the separate and corresponding instructions. When using a cupboard provided by the customer, please observe the corresponding instructions and its dimensions!

When using a flush-mounted cupboard, the floor distribution manifold is fixed or suspended in the cupboard. When using a wall-mounted cupboard, the floor distribution manifold is attached to the wall (see drilling template).

This requires: 4x drill hole Ø 10 mm, min. 60 mm deep, for stair bolts M8 x 80 mm

1. Use flush-mounted cupboard: Install the cupboard without the front frame according to the separate instructions.

Use wall-mounted cupboard: Drill suitable holes and screw the M8 stair bolts for the floor distribution manifold into the wall plugs in such a way that about 25 mm of each screw still stick out (see following drilling template).





2. Put the distance pieces onto the stair bolts / stud bolts. Place the preassembled PAW floor distribution manifold on the stair bolts / stud bolts and secure the distribution manifold with nuts.





- 3. Lay the connecting pipes in the cupboard. Please also refer to the separate operating instructions of the flat station.
- 4. Connect the connecting pipes with the corresponding ball valve. Connect the pipework for the radiant floor heating to the floor distribution manifold.

- 5. Connect the PAW flat station or a flat station provided by the customer in accordance with the separate instructions and screw the connections hand-tight. Align the station, if necessary.
- 6. Firmly tighten all screw connections. Place the cover caps on the stair bolts / stud bolts.
- 7. The PAW wall-mounted cupboard or the front frame of the PAW flush-mounted cupboard can now be hooked in and fixed (see separate instructions). A cupboard provided by the customer can now be mounted or completed in accordance with the corresponding instructions. Important: Ensure that the cupboard is sufficiently earthed!



4.2 Commissioning [specialist]



- Once the installation of the floor distribution manifold has been completed, we recommend a final pressure and leak test of the pipe:
 - with compressed air at 6 bar for 24 hours and then
 - with water at 6 bar for 3 days.
- 2. Flush and fill the radiant floor heating.
- 3. Use the safety cap to operate the filling and drain valves!



Setting the flow rate for each heating circuit:

Adjusting range of the flow rate = 0-5 l/min Reading accuracy = +/-15 % Maximum torque for setting the flow rate = 1 Nm Flow rate: Set to: $0.06 \text{ m}^{3}/\text{h}$ 1 l/min 0.12 m³/h 2 l/min 0.18 m³/h 3 l/min 0.24 m³/h 4 l/min 5 l/min 0.30 m³/h $K_{VS} = 0.78 \text{ m}^3/\text{h}$ completely open



Damage to property!

The flow meter is supplied with an adjustment wrench. The use of other wrenches can lead to damage.

• Only use the supplied wrench to adjust the flow meters!
